#### A LETTER FROM MR. HARRINGTON

#### Hello AMS parents and students!

We feel the excitement of our elementary staff and K-5 students as they have been back in school and in person learning since the beginning of January. Along with that, I am feeling even more excited as our staff plans for the return of our students this second semester. I know it feels like an eternity since our AMS family has been in school but it is on the horizon and in sight! We are working on all the logistics of getting staff and students back into our building safely. I have met the past two weeks with parents during "Coffee with the Principal" to answer questions and begin to talk about the details of our opening.

# As it stands, students will be back in two Cohorts, with periods 1-6 each day.

- Cohort A on Monday/Thursday
- Cohort B on Tuesday/Friday
- Wednesdays will have Hawks Nest in the morning with teacher office hours the rest of the morning and afternoon.
- I will go over all of this on Tuesday, February 2, in the Welcome Back to School Webinar.

Our counselors have been working diligently on our master schedule and balancing of classes. Please know that some students' schedules will change for 2nd semester to accommodate our in person schedule.

First semester will end on Friday, February 5. We have built time in during our Hawks Nest to support students who need to get assignments turned in and their grades up to passing. Again, if your student has not been invited to Hawks Nest, they DO NOT need to attend, EXCEPT the Wednesday morning Nest at 8:35. We will have a week in review out on Monday morning.

We have plans for our incoming 6th graders and <a href="new">new</a> students to AMS to get an opportunity to tour

our school with our 8th grade WEB leaders. 6th grade will be on Wednesday evening and 7th/8th grades on Thursday evening. Invites and details have been sent to those families. There is still a lot of planning in the works to have our staff ready for this launch. I appreciate all of your patience and support!
