- Log in to each class from a distraction free, quiet environment
 - Cell phones in another room

- Log in to your classes from your school computer with your first and last name - unknown screen names will not be admitted and will affect your attendance.

Be Productive:

- Participate in class through virtual classroom features as directed by your teacher
- Stay focused on your work and assignments during the school day
- Take scheduled breaks, eat a healthy lunch, and get some exercise daily
- If you need to take a short break, do so without interrupting the class
- Keep audio on mute until you want to speak
